WHEELCHAIR PRODUCTION ACCELERATES

Already **1099** wheelchairs have been given in 2021, and another **305** have been transported to 4 venues ready for July distribution. This total of **1404** is on track to top the total of 2614 distributed in 2020.

A total of **23,559** wheelchairs have been given since the beginning of this ministry 20 years ago—meaning thou-

sands of polio survivors, who otherwise would spend their lives crawling on the ground, have had their lives transformed by your generosity. Here are photos of recent distributions.

DID YOU KNOW

Although wild polio was eradicated in Nigeria in 2016, there are uncounted tens of thousands of polio survivors still needing wheelchairs.

Wheelchairs for Nigeria has zero overhead. Fundraising and travel expenses are paid privately. Every penny goes for a wheelchair—\$150 transforms a life.

Beautiful Gate Handicapped People Center, the Nigerian sister organization, has a local board and requires a certified audit of its finances each year.

\$22,000 is needed every month to maintain current production.
