For years, up until a year ago, my partner Ayuba Gufwan drove 50,000 miles a year all over Nigeria arranging wheelchair distributions. He didn't phone or write, he had to go in person and hope the government official, emir or pastor was "on seat." With Nigeria's rough roads, this meant very large expenses for repairs and regular vehicle replacement.

When Ayuba accepted his high position in the government in the capital Abuja a year ago, we prayed, who can do this now? Ayuba has become so famous and is so gifted in this, he is almost irreplaceable. Without distributions in villages and cities throughout Nigeria, what is the point in building wheelchairs?

Thirty of the 360 members of Nigeria's House of Representatives are on the People With Disabilities committee. They are all politicians. When they find out that Beautiful Gate will come to their district and give out 100 wheelchairs, they are eager to organize and host a distribution. Think of all the publicity and political good will! Now Ayuba doesn't have to drive a single mile. All he has to do is go to a committee meeting.

God continues to bless this ministry!
