"THE GREATEST SURPRISE OF MY LIFE"

Several years ago Ayuba talked to the Dakachi (Chief) of Balbadu, Jigawa State, about hosting a wheelchair distribution. He insisted there were only 10 or 12 disabled in his domain. Ayuba knew better and he and I brought 50 the first time, then 120, then 100 more. On March 20th he gave out 75 more and another 75 on March 27 (total 420) and the chief has another 86 on a waiting list! Mallam Usman Lamido, whose great grandfather was the king, thought he knew everything about his kingdom until the issue of wheelchairs for polio survivors came up. He continues to be astonished at the need.

This is very typical. If you could never get further from your house than you could crawl, you aren't going to be out much and no one will know about you.
